Nebosh introduced Open Book Examination to assess learners remotely. OBE is flexible approach to assessments, allowing learners to access to the materials, training notes or refer open sources during the exam.

The learners are given 24 hours to complete the scenario-based exams; they must upload their answers, they also must upload their practical risk assessment within 10 working days from OBE to the Nebosh examination portal before the time frame expires.

Following that, the learning partner conducts a closing interview with the learners based on the GIC1 theory exams. The main objective of the closing interview is to evaluate whether the learner genuinely completed the open book examination.

NEBOSH Open Book Examinations Journey

Registration

Learning Partners administer learner registration. It is important that you provide your Learning Partner with an accurate email address.

2



Confirmation of registration

You will receive an email with assessment registration confirmation that you have been registered to the OBE along with unit details on it.

3



Revise and prepare for your OBE

Explore the NEBOSH online examination platform

One week before the OBE you will receive a unique username and temporary password to the email address you provided. Log in, create a new password and familiarise yourself with the platform.

Examination day

At 11:00 BST the open book examination question paper will be available in the NEBOSH online examination platform. You have 24 hours to complete and submit your examination.

6



Closing interview

We will arrange a closing interview with you.

7



Practical Assessment

Upload risk assessment practicals within 10 working days from the date of GIC1 assessment.

8



Results

Results will be emailed to you 50 days after the examination date.

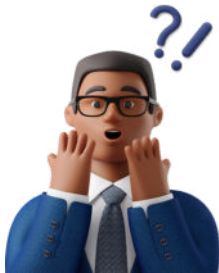
